## **CHAMPIONSHIP STRUCTURE**



The Action Clock by Protection Poker will be put into play after level 16. See WPT Action Clock Rules for more details. Time extension chips will accumulate and not be reset.

Single ante will be posted by the player in the big blind, in the amount equivalent to the big blind. Ante is posted before the big blind and players are eligible to collect the entire ante, even when out of the big blind. Ante is maintained until the completion of the tournament.

15 minute breaks after every 2 levels of play. There will not be a dinner break on Day 1 Day 2 will have a 60 minute dinner break after level 14.

\$3,200 + \$200 + \$100 = \$3,500.

Registration closes at the start of Level 11 on Day 2.

Day 1: 8, 60-minute levels.

Day 2: 10, 60- minute levels.

Day 3: 60 minute levels until the final table of six players is reached.

Day 4 (Final Table Live Stream) 60-minute levels until heads-up, then levels become 30 minutes in duration.

One in eight (1-in-8) entries will be in the money (approximately 12.5%). Winners must show valid ID to collect winnings. Residents of foreign countries will be subject to withholding, per casino policy. \$10,400 will be withheld from the prize pool and issued to 1st Place in the form of an entry to the WPT World Championship held in Las Vegas.

In order to play in the event, each player must have a Thunder Valley Player's Card and sign the mandatory WPT Player Release Form.

## PLAYERS PER TABLE

Unlimited re-entry is allowed until the start of level 11 on Day 2, when registration ends. This is not a best-stack forward event. Players may forfeit their stack to re-enter, if registration is still open.

Tournament Director Association (TDA) rules will be used, unless House Rules apply. Please, see tournament staff for House Rules. Participation in WPT tournaments is subject to rules and rulings set forth by the applicable venue(s) and/or WPT (e.g., tournament rules, sponsors). Tournament Director's decisions are final.

A redraw will occur at end of Day 1, 2, and 24, 16, and 9 players

50,000 tournament chips. Pre-purchased stacks will be "live" on the table from the beginning of the tournament. Late registrants and alternates will be sold a full starting stack.

This Event is eligible for WPT® Player of the Year.

**SEASON 22 - WPT® MAIN TOUR ACTION CLOCK RULES** 



- The Action Clock will be implemented into play after Level 16. While the Action Clock is in play, players must keep chips in stacks of 20, whenever possible.
- The Action Clock will be controlled by the dealer. Dealers will start the Action Clock following the completion of each deal once the last card has been dealt. When players act in turn, the Action Clock will be reset, with each player receiving a fresh clock to begin their action, as outlined below.

WPT Main Tour	Pre-Flop	Post-Flop
Day 2 (after Level 16)	15 seconds	30 seconds
Day 3	20 seconds	30 seconds
Day 4 (final 6 players)	30 seconds	30 seconds

- · When a bet or raise has been made, the dealer will first count the bet or raise size, announce the amount, and then start the clock for the next action. If a player calls the bet, the dealer will reset the clock to begin the next player's action.
- Pre-Flop: for a player's initial pre-flop action they will receive 15, 20, or 30 seconds, per the table listed above. For any additional pre-flop action (e.g., facing a 3-bet), the player will receive 30 seconds to make their follow-up decision.
- When players receive 15 or 20 seconds to act, dealers will **not** advise players when the Action Clock reaches 10 seconds.
- When players receive 30 seconds to act, dealers will advise players when the Action Clock reaches 10 seconds.
- To begin play in the Action Clock portion of the tournament, each player will receive time-extension chips. Each timeextension chip is worth a 30-second addition to a player's action.

WPT Main Tour	Number of Time Extension Chips (Per Player)
Day 2 (after Level 16)	Five (5) time-extension chips, per player
Day 3 (start of the day)	Five (5) time-extension chips, per player
Day 3 (at 24 players)	Five (5) time-extension chips, per player
Day 4 (final 6 players)	Five (5) time-extension chips, per player

- Players are required to keep their remaining time-extension chips visible at all times.
- · At the conclusion of play each day, any unused time extension chips will be placed in the players' tournament chip bag and will carry over to the next tournament day. Time extensions are to be treated with the same level of importance as tournament chips, and removal of time extensions may be subject to penalty up to and including disqualification. If a player does not use any of their time chips and reaches the final table, they will be limited to a maximum of 20 time extension chips.
- If a player wishes to use a time-extension chip, the player is to pass the time-extension chip forward to the dealer in exchange for an additional 30 seconds to be added to their Action Clock.
- In the case that the Action Clock expires for a player with remaining time-extension chips, the player's Action Clock will be automatically extended an additional 30 seconds before the dealer collects the time-extension chip(s) used. Collection will take place at the end of the player's action. If a player's Action Clock expires and the player does not have any time-extension chips remaining, they will be (a) forced to check if there is no bet pending or (b) fold if facing a bet or a raise.
- The Action Clock will never be paused unless there is an extreme situation that calls for play to be halted.
- Tournament play will start eight-handed.

## WPT Player of The Year: How to win

WPT Player of the Year points are awarded based on the total prize pool of the tournament. During Season XXII of the World Poker Tour, the winner of the WPT Player of the Year award will be the player who earns the most POY points during the period comprising such WPT Season. In the event of a tie on points, the following tiebreaking system will apply (only move to the next numbered tiebreaker if players tying are still equal):

1st tiebreaker: Most Titles 2nd tiebreaker: Most Final Tables 3rd tiebreaker: Most In The Points 4th tiebreaker: Most \$ Won

4th tiebreaker notes - In the event a jurisdiction/casino allows deal making, then the individual cashes as listed by the venue will be shown on WPT channels and distribution networks. If the jurisdiction/casino does not allow deal making, then individual cashes will be shown as per the official prizepool on WPT channels and distribution networks.

The date used to determine the USD exchange rate for non USD POY events is the closing exchange rate for Day 1A as per Wall Street Journal

The WPT POY will apply to all WPT major global tour events including Main Tour, WPTDeepStacks, Prime and other branded events designated as POY eligible. Invitational and/or Qualifiers only Events will not count.

Players must finish in the money to earn POY points.

A player qualifying more than once In The Money in an Event will only receive points for his/her highest placing in that Event.
